

Recognizing Your Child's Emotions

Young children often experience big feelings but don't yet have the words or skills to express them. Tantrums, tears, or frustration are a normal part of learning emotional regulation – not a sign of misbehavior.

One helpful strategy at home is to name the feeling you're seeing, such as "You look upset" or "That was really frustrating," which
