

The Value of Children's Art

Give toddlers some crayons, and they start scribbling randomly. The more they scribble, the more they are able to control the crayon and its movements across the paper. As they learn to control their scribbling, they start creating shapes, which eventually become the shapes necessary to write the letters of the alphabet.

Art projects can be as easy as giving kids some supplies and letting them create freely. Parents and teachers should briefly model how to use the tools, but then allow the child to create however they'd like using the materials provided.
