## Hugs, Waves, High Fives, Fist Bumps or Handshakes?

Every child has the right to decide who they feel comfortable hugging and when. It's important to give your child permission to politely say no if they don't want to hug or kiss someone.

Learning about boundaries and consent are important lessons about respecting their own feelings and not being pressured into hugging or kissing someone.

Some parents may be concerned that their child will appear to be rude or disrespectful if they refuse to hug or kiss someone, especially when the person is a close friend or relative. However, it's more important for your child to understand that their body belongs to them.

It's important to get a child's consent every time before initiating a simple hug. This allows the child to have the final say in what happens to his body. This is a life-long lesson that is carried into adulthood.
