Swimming is fun

Swimming season is here, and we can all have fun at the pool, river or lake, but we should also rethink a few water safety rules.

The #1 rule is to never swim alone. Even adults should make sure someone watches when you swim.

Children should start swimming lessons at six months. It only takes a minute for a child to slip below the surface, so they should be closely supervised. Put away your phone and pay close attention because kids drown silently and quickly, often when they are vertical in the water with their head tipped back. They rarely splash, flail their arms, or yell for help. Intervene when a kid may be in trouble so he doesn't get to the point of drowning.

Talk with your kids about all aspects of water safety. We should teach young children that water can be dangerous, just like cars. Remember that a child can drown in less than two inches of water and that constant supervision is needed for children to be safe.
